SCRIP cards are a super easy way for SJCA families to earn tuition dollars. Here's how SCRIP works:

- Participating retailers give SJCA a percentage back every time you purchase a physical gift card, reload or ScripNow! certificate.
- SCRIP order forms can be submitted at the Lower Campus main office and the Upper Campus Development Office.
- Orders are placed on Monday mornings and sent home on Fridays during the school year.
- Profits can benefit your SJCA tuition account, SJCA Parent Association, or a Kenosha parish.
- Rebates accrued now through April 30, 2020 will be applied to the tuition accounts for the 2020-2021 school year.

Stop in the Development Office this summer to purchase your SCRIP cards! This summer, we will be ordering from suppliers every other week. The first order dates are June 24 followed by July 8. Please keep in mind that SCRIP cards can be purchased from our stocked supply on Mondays through Thursdays from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. in the Upper Campus Development Office, Door 10.
