

Busing Information for MIDDLE and HIGH School Students for the 2019-2020 School Year

KENOSHA BUSING

Kenosha busing is free to those Middle and Upper School students who qualify. Students who live over 2 miles from St. Joseph Catholic Academy and within the Kenosha Unified School District are eligible for busing. (Other district regulations may also apply.) Every SJCA family who lives in Wisconsin will be receiving a busing form in the mail next week. If you think you may be eligible for busing, please take the time to fill out the form. The form is also available by clicking below.

- All forms and requests must be turned in to the Upper Campus Main office before July 12th. Please do not call the busing company.
- All busing requests will then be sent to Kenosha Unified for the determination of eligibility, bus stops, and the various routes and times.
- Parents/guardians will be notified in August, before school begins, as to the route and times for their student.
- If your student does not qualify for the school bus, some students will be granted a "city bus pass" to ride the city bus, also free of charge. Information is available through the City Transit Office regarding times and stops that the city bus makes.
- Currently there is no busing to the Lower Campus, however, SJCA will be exploring possible options for the 2020-2021 school year.

ILLINOIS BUSING

Busing is currently available to all Illinois Middle and Upper School students for a fee per student. Due to Illinois state law, busing students over state lines has some limitations. When a Wisconsin school bus crosses over the state line to pick up students, it is limited to the parking lot of businesses, churches, and schools. The buses will NOT be able to stop at private residences, private driveways, or along roadsides. If you are interested in busing from Illinois:

- All forms and requests must be turned in to the Upper Campus Main office before July 12th. Please do not call the busing company.

- Parents/guardians are notified in August, before school begins, as to the route and times for their student.
