



Sister Gertrude Wissing Memorial Scholarship

Purpose: The Sister Gertrude Wissing Memorial Scholarship was created in honor of Sister Gertrude for the many years of servitude she gave to St. Mark Catholic School and St. Joseph High School as an educator and administrator. This scholarship will be given to students who have demonstrated leadership ability in school, church, community or extracurricular activities. The Sister Gertrude Scholarship Memorial Scholarship fund will award up to three (3) \$500 scholarships annually: one for an incoming 6th grader, 7th grader, and 8th grader. The money will be applied to the student's tuition at St. Joseph Catholic Academy.

Eligibility:

- Demonstrate strong Christian-centered values and a desire to pursue a Catholic education
- Maintain good academic standing
- Participate in extracurricular activities or church/community service

Scholarship Requirements:

- Be registered at St. Joseph Catholic Academy for the upcoming school year
- Provide a copy of the most recent report card
- Present one letter of recommendation from a current teacher, current principal and/or parish priest.
- Write a short essay on what attending St. Joseph Catholic Academy means to you.

All relevant documents must be turned in together by ***April 3rd, 2020*** with the scholarship application to be considered complete.
