## TUITION

At St. Joseph Catholic Academy, we know that making the investment in a Catholic school education can be a significant sacrifice. SJCA is committed to making an SJCA education affordable to all qualified students to the extent that our resources allow. ### PARISH DISCOUNT

Families who are registered members of a Kenosha Catholic Parish are eligible for a \$250 tuition discount per student up to \$500 per family. Parishes include Our Lady of Holy Rosary, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, St. Anne, St. Anthony, St. Elizabeth, St. James, St. Mark, St. Mary, St. Peter, and St. Therese. Discounts apply only to tuition.

### FAMILY DISCOUNT PLAN

Discounts apply only to tuition.

**The maximum family discount for preschool is limited to 20%.**

- 1<sup>st</sup> student..... full tuition
- 2<sup>nd</sup> student..... 10% discount
- 3<sup>rd</sup> student ..... 20% discount
- 4 or more students ..... 100% discount

**Parent Association Fee** (required for all students)

- One student..... \$50

- Middle School Athletic Fee (per student/per sport)..... determined by sport
- Elementary School Athletic Fee (per student/per sport).... determined by sport

**Theater Participation Fee**

- Musicals (cast and crew) ..... \$150
- Little Lancer Theater ..... \$50

**Tuition and fees do not cover all school expenses, including the following:**

## **PAYMENT OPTIONS • DISCOUNTS • TUITION ASSISTANCE**

### **FLEXIBLE PAYMENT OPTIONS**

SJCA recognizes that everyone's financial situation is different. We will work with all of our families to find a way to make SJCA affordable. We offer several payment options to meet your family's needs. Families who want to pay monthly must enroll in the **SMART TUITION** payment plan when they register.

### **MULTI-STUDENT DISCOUNTS**

We are pleased to offer discounts to families who have more than one child attending SJCA in Kindergarten through 12th grade. A family pays full tuition for the first child, the second child receives a 10% discount, the 3rd child receives a 20% discount, and the 4th and subsequent children receive 100% discount. Regardless of the number of students in a family, a 3K and 4K preschool student will not receive more than 20% discount.

### **KENOSHA/PLEASANT PRAIRIE PARISH DISCOUNT**

Registered members of Kenosha/Pleasant Prairie parishes receive a \$250 parish discount per student up to \$500 per family for all grades 3K Preschool through Grade 12.

### **TUITION ASSISTANCE**

SJCA awards approximately \$400,000 in tuition assistance annually - approximately \$200,000 in need-based assistance and over \$200,000 in scholarships funded by generous donors. Tuition assistance is not available for international students. SJCA utilizes the services of an independent company, **FACTS**, to assist us in the evaluation of need. Tuition assistance is given at the school's discretion based on an assessment of the family's financial need and on the availability of funds; preference is given to families who have children already attending the school. While it is not possible to fulfill all financial aid requests, St. Joseph Catholic Academy makes every effort to help as many families as resources allow. Tuition assistance is awarded once a student has been admitted.

### **WISCONSIN PARENTAL CHOICE PROGRAM (WPCP)**

St. Joseph Catholic Academy participates in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP). The WPCP is a state program that provides qualifying students the opportunity to attend SJCA without paying tuition. We encourage all families who qualify to consider completing an application for this program. The application period opens on February 1, 2021.

### **SCRIP PROGRAM**

SCRIP is a term that means "substitute money." SCRIP is gift certificates and prepaid cards that are used just like cash to purchase everyday expenses like food, clothing, and other essentials. With every SCRIP purchase, you earn revenue for the SJCA Parent Association and tuition assistance for you. The Parent Association buys SCRIP at a discount (from 1.5% to 20%) and that percentage is our organization's revenue. The rebate from each certificate is split between the Parent Association (50%) and your family designation (50%). We've had families earn up to \$1,500 per year for their SJCA tuition.
