

GRADES 6-12

St. Joseph Catholic Academy acknowledges that students of different ages require varying needs of Cooperative Virtual Learning. Administration at both campuses have developed grade-appropriate plans to assist students who are impacted by Covid-19.

Starting Tuesday, September 7th, 2021, St. Joseph Catholic Academy students in Grades 6-12 who are impacted by Covid illness, or who must quarantine due to a close contact exposure from family, sports, etc., will be offered two virtual learning options. When the school is contacted by the local health department or by a parent regarding a Covid illness and/or a close contact case, these options will be open to students who meet the above criteria and will be absent for more than four (4) school days.

Virtual Classroom Participation:

- Students will log into each class daily through classroom Zoom links.
- They will be able to view, listen and participate in the classrooms.
- If a student chooses this option while quarantined and becomes ill, the parent will need to call the office to inform them of the illness so attendance is appropriately documented.
- Students will abide by cooperative learning guidelines as outlined by St. Joseph Catholic Academy's Student Services Department at the time of quarantine.

Self Directed Remote Learning:

- Students who select this option will be independently managing their coursework at home.
- Individuals will be responsible for monitoring Canvas and completing assignments by the due dates posted.
- Students will not be joining class via Zoom. They may, and should, contact their teacher through email with questions or concerns.
- If an assessment occurs during the student's absence, administering the test on a specific date (virtual or back in person) will be determined at the teacher's discretion.
- If meetings with a teacher are required, they will be scheduled during school operating hours.
